As I write this note to you I'm finishing up my time in Arkansas and making plans to be with you all in mid-January. The chapter wraps up with another reminder of His comfort; that He is with us and is our fortress. I don't know who else needs to hear that truth today, but I find it to be wonderful and just another reason I am thankful for who our great God is.

So, as our time together draws closer and closer here are a couple of things that we can be praying together for:

- 1) That the Lord would prepare our hearts for the work that is ahead. Change is hard, growth is often painful, but knowing and remembering that the glory of God going forth in our city is worth it.
- 2) That the Lord would create and maintain unity amongst the church. So often when the church is preparing to do great things for God the evil one tries to push in and divide. Let's pray together against this.
- 3) That above all else, we would keep the Gospel of Jesus and His glory as our number one and highest priority.

Finally, please remember to continue to pray for me and my family! We covet your prayers and could not go through this process without them. Please pray that the Lord will provide the perfect job for Nan, that we would have wisdom in choosing the right school for both Micah and Zeke, and that as we search for a permanent home we would listen to and trust the Lord in that process.
