
Hey Church!



This summer as we're studying the Psalms together on Sundays, I get the chance to spend time reconnecting with some of my favorite sections of scripture. One of them that I revisited lately is Psalm 100:2. It says, "Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs." In this Psalm the word for "worship" literally means, "to serve". So, serve the Lord with gladness... Wow! How many times do I forget that service is an act of worship! I believe that it is impossible to have a healthy relationship with God without serving others. This should be a focal point in how we interact with humanity - by serving them. This will always look different for different people based on age or even season of life, but we should all be worshipping Jesus by serving his creation! Did you catch the second part of that verse? It says we do this with gladness!

Ask yourself the question, "How do you feel when you are serving?". Do you see it as worship or as duty? It's not a duty!
