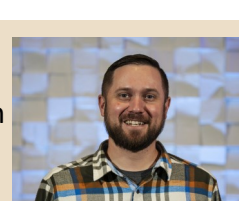

All throughout scripture we see examples of prayer. We see Jesus teach us how to pray and we see him model it on several different occasions. In the Pauline literature several times Paul asks for prayer for his work and we see him instruct the church at Thessalonica to pray specifically for the gospel to go forth. I've said it before, and I still believe it today: a praying church is a powerful weapon in the hands of a mighty God. Here are a couple of specific ways you can be praying for your church in the coming days:

- 1) Pray that God would provide a worship leader for us! Pray for our hearts to be ready and eager to welcome this new person and their family. 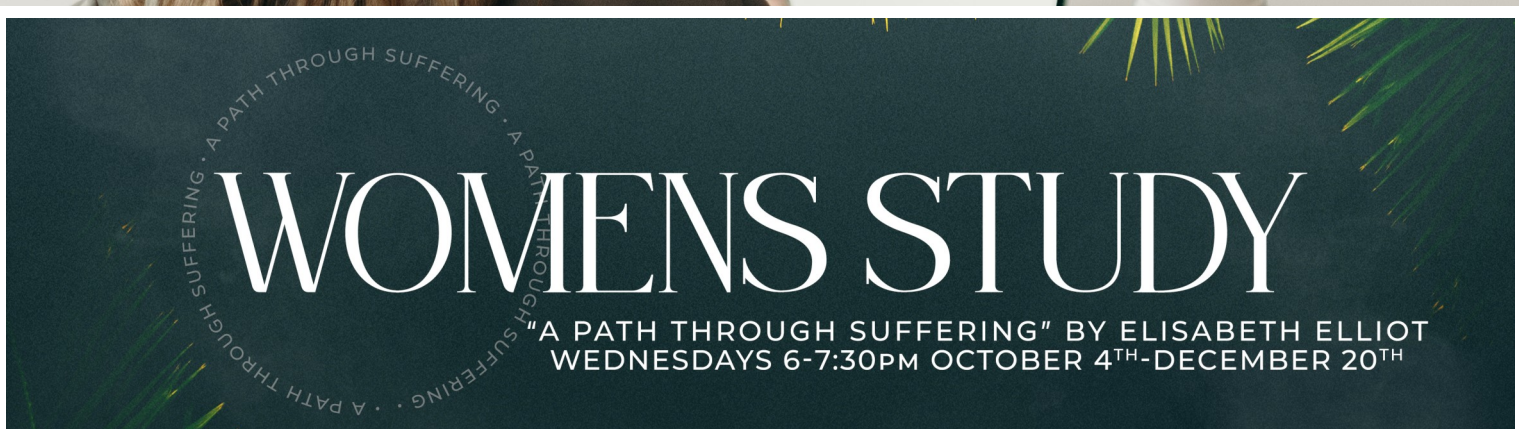
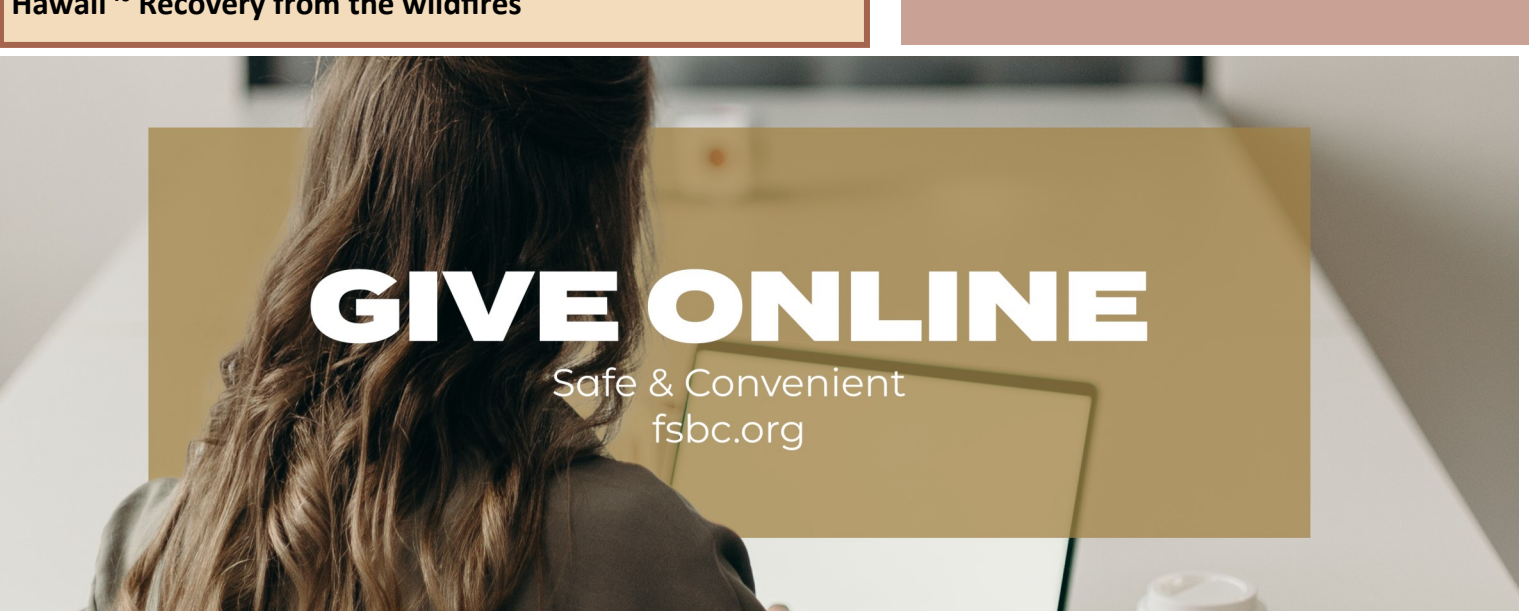
