Hey Church!



2026 brings 75 years of ministry that FSBC has had in our city! Wow, what an incredible legacy! I've been spending a lot of time over the last couple of months thinking about the word and concept of hindrance. It it is simply something that provides resistance, delay, or obstruction to someone or something. If we think about it, in our lives we are constantly trying to remove or minimize hindrances. Not necessarily to make something easier, but often to make something more effective, efficient, or simply better. Think about it for a moment - you are a runner and you're trying to shave seconds off your mile time. You might change your diet, work out plan, shoes, or even get a running partner all in order to remove hindrances from achieving your goal. Or consider your finances. You have financial goals and do what you need to to remove hindrances. Maybe you get rid of that credit card, fine tune your budget, hire a financial advisor, go back to school or acquire another skill, all in order to reach your financial goals.

As a church, we to have to regularly stop and consider things that may be hindrances to church growth, maturity, and reaching people with the gospel. Now, don't read between the lines and make that idea say something I didn't! Ha! The gospel doesn't need any help, it's the gospel - it's good enough on it's own. But, there can be things that hinder people from hearing, being receptive to, and seeing it lived out. Recognizing this doesn't downplay the power of the gospel, or minimize the work of the Holy Spirit.

In the Bible hindrances to the gospel include false prophets and deceptive teachings (Matthew 7), worldly desires (Luke 8, Matthew 19), living an inconsistent life that doesn't match Jesus' teachings (Galatians 2), and arrogance or apathy toward sharing the gospel. Taking time to assess our lives, and our church, to remove any hindrances is always a good thing. Self assessments and reflections can be painful though! We start running into things that we like. We start running into personal preferences and traditions and loose sight of the fact that if those things, while maybe good in general, are affecting our ability to reach people with the saving gospel of Jesus Christ, then they need to be changed! They must change. We must constantly be assessing to ensure that we are not only sharing a timeless truth with the world, but that we are using timely methods. Churches that get stuck in ruts quickly loose their effectiveness, and shortly there after become irrelevant. My prayer is that these things will never be said of our body!

2026 is coming quick, and as we celebrate the 75 years of ministry our church has had in our city, let us pray together that we would be wise enough to do what is necessary to ensure that we have another 75 years of effective ministry - for the good of our city and the glory of God. It's a pleasure to be your Pastor and I cannot wait to see what God does in the days to come.
